"FOR FREEDOM, CHRIST HAS SET US FREE"

In today's second reading, Paul contrasts life "in the flesh" with life "in the Spirit." The freedom to which Christ calls us is not primarily about self-will or self-indulgence, but about the possibility of living entirely for God, offering our lives in loving service to God, to neighbour, and to the world. When we live in this way, then we are truly free: free to embrace the identity given to us by our loving God. That kind of discipleship, Jesus points out in the Gospel, comes at a price: it may mean letting go of our need for security, for attachments, for the praise and recognition by others. But it is worth it!

It was wonderful to celebrate all our volunteers last weekend, recognizing the many ways in which literally hundreds of people serve our parish and the broader community. As we wind down for a well-deserved summer rest, let us recommit to the mission statement our parish developed and embraced in 1989, and which is still ours today:

"St. Monica's Parish, originally established to meet the needs of a people recovering from war, has ministered since then to our changing community. We who choose St. Monica's Roman Catholic parish, are challenged by Scripture and inspired by the Holy Spirit:

- to come together to celebrate in Word and Sacrament our faith in Jesus Christ;
- to recognize the dignity of each person;
- to appreciate the gifts each individual brings to our community;
- to celebrate the diversity that various small communities bring to our parish family;
- to work for justice and peace in our church and in society;
- to have a particular compassion for young, elderly, poor and disadvantaged people, while affirming the equality of all."

In this way, we seek to live out the words of Scripture: "This is what God asks of you, only this: to act justly, to love tenderly, and to walk humbly with your God." (Micah 6:8)
