## **CELEBRATING GOD'S FAITHFULNESS**

Anniversaries are special occasions. And what a weekend this is! For we celebrate not just one, but **three** anniversaries of priestly ordination: for Fr. Adelchi Bertoli, on July 8, 1951, at the Duomo SS. Ermacora e Fortunato di Udine; for Fr. Gerald Westphal, right here at St. Monica's, on September 17, 1976; and finally for myself, Fr. It is a tall task to embrace, but made possible by the grace of God, by the generous support of loving family and friends of integrity, and by a supportive community to whom and with whom we serve. For all of these, we are profoundly grateful!

Thank you to all those who have helped – not only in this celebration, but also in the individual celebrations for myself in July and for Fr. Bertoli in August. May this beautiful prayer of St. Ignatius of Loyola express our desire to continue to serve the Lord and his people for many years to come.
