
MARY, MOTHER OF THE CHURCH

So much is happening in our community! Liturgically, it is the sixth Sunday of Easter, and our readings are rich with the promise of Pentecost. And let us remember those who, though not mothers in the biological sense, generously nurture and bless the younger generation as teachers, mentors, caregivers, and spiritual guides.
