"Development and Peace" have been financially impacted by the pandemic due to the inability to hold a nationwide Lenten Collection. This collection was projected to raise \$7 million dollars. - 4. Build resilience to prevent future crisis.
- 5. Build solidarity and equity across communities, generations and borders.
