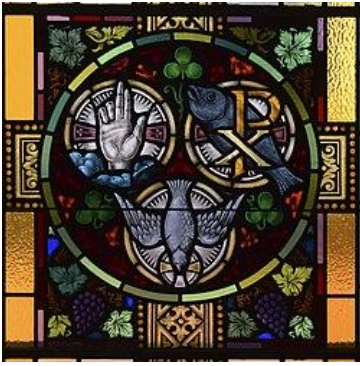

### **THE TRINITY: THE ETERNAL COMMUNION OF DIVINE LOVE**

The feast of the Most Holy Trinity draws us into the very heart of God – a mystery of eternal love, perfect communion, and divine unity. The Trinity reveals that God is relationship. From all eternity, the Father gives Himself completely to the Son, the Son lives in perfect communion with the Father, and the Holy Spirit proceeds as the living breath of that divine love. In God there is no division, no isolation, no possessiveness; there is only endless self-giving and perfect harmony.

Human life finds its deepest meaning in this mystery. Every person carries within the soul a longing for love, belonging, and communion because humanity is created in the image of the Triune God. Whenever love heals wounds, whenever forgiveness restores relationships, whenever sacrifice is offered for another, the life of the Trinity becomes visible in the world.

The mystery of the Trinity becomes a living invitation to move beyond fear and separation into unity rooted in love and truth. The Church herself exists as a reflection of this divine communion, called to gather people into one family under God.

Every time we make the Sign of the Cross, we enter this sacred mystery; the Father who creates us, the Son who redeems us, and the Holy Spirit who sanctifies and guides us. The Trinity remains the source from which all life flows and the destiny toward which every soul journeys – eternal communion with God in love everlasting.



### **CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION: JUNE 7<sup>th</sup> – FOLLOWING THE 11:00 AM MASS**

The Feast of Corpus Christi invites us to deepen our love and reverence for the Holy Eucharist; the precious gift Christ has entrusted to His Church. In the Eucharist, Jesus continues to remain with His people in a real and living way, nourishing us with His presence and drawing us into communion with Him and with one another. Every Mass becomes a sacred encounter where we are strengthened in faith, renewed in hope, and united in charity.

One of the most beautiful traditions connected to this solemn feast is the Eucharistic Procession. Carrying the Blessed Sacrament through our streets is a public expression of our faith and devotion, reminding us that Christ walks with His people in every moment of life. As we pray and process together, we place our families, homes, parish, and community under the loving care and blessing of the Eucharistic Lord.

This year, our parish family will gather for a special Corpus Christi celebration on Sunday, June 7<sup>th</sup>. To allow everyone to participate together in this important celebration, there will be one Mass only at **11:00am**, followed immediately by the Eucharistic Procession. Please note that there will be no 9:00am Mass that morning.

I warmly encourage all parishioners and families to join this sacred celebration with prayerful hearts and joyful spirit. Your presence will help make this procession a meaningful witness of faith within our

community. May this feast renew in each of us a deeper love for Christ in the Blessed Sacrament and strengthen us as one parish family gathered around the Eucharistic table.
