PREPARING OUR HEARTS FOR TWO GREAT FEASTS OF JUNE

The month of June holds a special place in the life of the Church as we celebrate two beautiful feasts that invite us to reflect on God's love and the example of faithful discipleship: The Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus (June 12), and the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary (June 13).

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)

The Feast of Corpus Christi invites us to pause in wonder before one of the greatest gifts Christ has given to His Church: The Holy Eucharist. On this day, we celebrate not merely a symbol or a sacred remembrance, but the real presence of Jesus Christ—His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—offered to us under the appearances of bread and wine.

At the Last Supper, Jesus took bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to His disciples saying, "This is my Body." He took the cup and said, "This is my Blood." Through these words, He established the Eucharist as the lasting memorial of His people throughout the ages.

The Eucharist is the heart of the Church. Every Mass makes present the sacrifice of Christ on Calvary and unites heaven and earth. In receiving Holy Communion, we are drawn into a profound communion with Christ and with one another. The Eucharist strengthens us in faith, heals our hearts, forgives venial sins, and sends us forth to be witnesses of Christ's love in the world.

As we celebrate this beautiful feast, may our hearts be renewed with gratitude for the gift of the Eucharist. May we approach the altar with deeper faith, greater reverence, and a sincere desire to become what we receive: the Body of Christ for the life of the world.
